



TES – Radio Schedule

Prerequisites:

This functionality is only available for events set up by TopYacht as **Off Shore**.

Setup:

There are 3 steps in setting up and using the TES Radio Sched. These are accessible under the **Off Shore** menu item at the top of the TES admin screen.

Step 1: Create/Update Session

Set Up / Alter Radio Sched for A Race

To Create a new Radio Sched Session
Step 1: Press `Create NEW Sched Session`
Step 2: Provide new session name
Step 3: Add relevant Races to the Session
Step 3: Save the Changes

Create NEW sched session

Sched Session Name: Sess ID:3

Select Session: ▼

Save Changes

Follow the steps, in order, as displayed in the on screen dialog.

Set Up / Alter Radio Sched for A Race

To Create a new Radio Sched Session
Step 1: Press `Create NEW Sched Session`
Step 2: Provide new session name
Step 3: Add relevant Races to the Session
Step 3: Save the Changes

Create NEW sched session

Sched Session Name: Sess ID:21

Select Session: ▼

Save Changes

Select Series to include in Session.
 Auckland to Russell Yacht Race - Multihull
 Auckland to Russell Yacht Race - Monohull

Step 2: Add Check Points As per the on screen prompts

Select the Session then press the Add new check point button for each check point. In the example below, the third schedule point has been added.

Save the change by clicking another cell or clicking the Add button again. Confirmation of this is with a halo forming around the recently-edited field.

Set Up / Alter Radio Sched for A Race

Step 1: Select Session

Step 2: Add/Edit of Sched details

Select session: Ack 2 Russ ▼

Add new check point

Order	Check Point
1	Flat Rock
2	Sail Rock
3	Cape Brett

Step 3: Log

Select the relevant session.

The time a boat radios in can be added by simply clicking the GO button or manually entered it in the format of the day in the month, concatenated with the time (in 24 hr time notation) ie 21st at 11:56 in the example below.

There is also provision for notes in the **notes** field. This can contain lots more data than just in the **notes** edit box as it is accessed by a pop up edit area. Use this area to record DNF, broken gear etc etc.
